CornerHouse operates a valuable 'resource' for the voluntary sector encouraging and fostering the creation of voluntary groups. It assists them in their activities by providing advice, support and a place where meetings and social events can be held.

CornerHouse is a fine example of practical and effective public sector/voluntary sector partnership. The North West Surrey Mental Health Partnership NHS Trust provides the building, Surrey County Council provides financial support, and CornerHouse facilitates the provision of non-statutory services.
